## FROM AND TO THE AIRPORT

There are two airports in Warsaw, one is the Chopin Airport and the other is Modlin Airport.

Chopin Airport is located in Warsaw (10 – 15 minutes from the city centre). The easiest way to reach the city centre from Chopin Airport is to take a taxi (about 30 – 40 PLN). If you prefer to take public transport – you can take a bus from the airport. You should take a bus no 175 that departs from Chopin Airport every 15 minutes. You need to purchase the 20 min. or 75 min. ticket – there are ticket machines at the airport and you can purchase tickets in kiosks that are at the arrival terminal. Bus no 175 will take you directly to the Pilsudski Square – next to the Victoria Sofitel Hotel. This is the last stop of this bus.

Modlin Airport is located outside of Warsaw. The easiest way to get to the centre of the town from Modlin Airport is by taxi (about 120 – 150 PLN). It is also possible to get there by public transport: you need to take a bus shuttle to the train station and then take a SKM (red) or Koleje Mazowieckie (green) train to the centre of Warsaw. The tickets are available in kiosks and should be available on the bus. Please follow the signs at the airport – they explain how to get to the train – there is also an information stand in the main hall. If you decide to take a train – it will take you to the Warsaw Central Railway Station. It is possible to get to the Victoria Sofitel Hotel on foot (it should take you about 20 minutes). Alternatively, you can take a taxi from the Warsaw Central Railway Station or a bus no 175 (as above, in the Pilsudski Square direction) or you can walk to the tram stop called “Centrum” and take a tram no 4, 15, 18 or 35 in the Plac Bankowy direction. If you take a tram you need to get off on “Królewska” stop (it is the second stop from “Centrum”).

## MONEY AND BANKS

Currency in Poland is zloty (PLN), 1 PLN = 100 groszy.

The current exchange rate is approximately 1 EUR = 4,20 PLN

Credit cards are widely accepted in many places like restaurants, hotels and shopping centers.

ATM machines are available in front of most of the bank offices and other public places.

### **SHOPPING**

There are two big shopping malls close to the city centre. One is next to the Central Railway Station – ZŁOTE TARASY (Golden Terraces) and the other is 5 minutes by taxi from the City Centre – ARKADIA. There are also nice shops in the Nowy Swiat Street and the Old Town area.

### **ELECTRICITY**

The electricity plugs used in Poland are standard two round pin plugs (230 V).

### **EMERGENCIES**

The national telephone number for all emergency services is 112 or 997 for the police.
