## ATHENS SIGHTSEEING THE ACROPOLIS AND THE NEW ACROPOLIS MUSEUM

### Half-day Morning Tour

Daily Service

Departure 08.45 - Return 13.30

This tour gives you an opportunity to observe the striking contrasts that make Athens such a fascinating city. Our expert guides will take you to see the Panathenaic Stadium where the first Olympic Games of modern times were held in 1896 (short stop).

Continue and pass by the Temple of Olympian Zeus, Hadrian's Arch, the Parliament and the Memorial to the Unknown Soldier, the Academy, the University, the National Library and Constitution Square (Syntagma).

On the Acropolis, visit the Architectural Masterpieces of the Golden Age of Athens: the Propylaea, the Temple of Athena Nike, the Erechtheion and finally "the harmony between material and spirit", the Parthenon monument.

Continue and visit the new Acropolis Museum which houses significant statues and admire the wonders of the classical era.

N.B. 1) Every Monday the new Acropolis Museum is closed

N.B. 2) Due to certain restrictions in the visiting hours of the new Acropolis Museum the order of the program can be changed.

This tour gives you an opportunity to observe the striking contrasts that make Athens such a fascinating city. Our expert guides take you to see the center of the city. Constitution square (Syntagma), the House of Parliament, the Memorial to the Unknown Soldier and the National Library.

On your way to the Acropolis, you will see the Hadrian's Arch, visit the Temple of Olympian Zeus and you will make a short stop at the Panathenaic Stadium where the first Olympic Games of the modern era were held in 1896.

## ATHENS WALKING CITY TOUR WITH ACROPOLIS

### Half-day Morning Tour

Dep. 09.45 from Amalia Hotel - Tour ends approximately 13.00hrs at the Acropolis

The Tour, which is a must while in Athens, begins in front of the House of Parliament in Syntagma Square where you will see the Monument of the Unknown Soldier and the change of the famous Euzony Guards.

A pleasant walk will follow through the National Gardens and onto the Zappeion Hall, the Temple of Olympian Zeus and Hadrian's Arch. From here you will enter the Plaka Area heading to the Acropolis and visit with your guide the Propylaia, the Temple of Nike, and the Parthenon, the Monuments that remind us of the glory of Ancient Athens and the Golden Age of Pericles. You will also see the surrounding Athenian Agora, the Observatories, the Hill of Democracy (Pnyx), Mars and Philopappos Hill, the Odeon of Herodes Atticus and the Theater of Dionysus. At the end of the tour and since you are so close, don't miss the opportunity to visit, on your own, the new Acropolis museum.

N.B.: The Entrance Fee (12,00€) to the Acropolis is not included in the price.

On the way, you have a splendid view of the Saronic Gulf and the little islands offshore. After visiting the Temple of Poseidon, you have time to leisurely walk on the rocky promontory of Sounion.

## DELPHI ONE DAY

Dep. 08.45 - Ret. 19.00

Drive through the fertile plain of Beotia, crossing the towns of Thebes (connected with the tragedy of King Oedipus) Levadia and Arachova (short stop on the way back). Arrive at Delphi, the center of the Ancient World- the "Omphalos" (Navel of Earth) – whose prestige extended far beyond the boundaries of the Hellenic World. On the slopes of Mount Parnassus, in a landscape of unparalleled beauty, lie the ruins of the Sanctuary of Apollo Pythios. Visit the Treasury of the Athenians, the Temple of Apollo and the Museum containing masterpieces of Ancient Greek sculptures such as the bronze Charioteer and the famous athlete Aghias. Lunch in the modern village of Delphi, return to Athens by the same route.

## ARGOLIS ONE DAY

Departure on the coastal road along the Saronic Gulf to the Corinth Canal (short stop). Drive to Mycenae, the Homeric city of Atreides, the city "rich in gold" of the ancient poets.

Visit the Lion's Gate, the Cyclopean Walls, the Royal Tombs etc. Depart for Nauplion through the fertile plain of Argolis, the picturesque town nestling at the foot of a cliff crowned by the mighty ramparts of the Palamidi Fortress (short photo stop), leave for Epidauros, to visit the Theatre (4th century B.C) famous for its astonishing acoustics. Return to Athens on the national road connecting Epidauros with Corinth. Lunch in Mycenae.

The drive back to Aegina Port will give you time to relax and appreciate the exquisite peaceful nature of the island.

A panoramic bus tour, giving you the opportunity to drive across the entire island (without visiting the archeological site) admiring the beauty of its nature, the islands medieval capital of Paleohora, the Church of St. Nectarios, the pistachio groves...
