Steve Acunto is President of CINN Group, Inc., an insurance publishing, non-profit management, and communications company, whose publications include the bi-weekly *Insurance Advocate* (founded in 1889) among several others. CINN realizes an annual schedule of public policy and financial services conferences across the United States and serves as the management facility for several national and international professional and non-profit organizations.

Mr. Acunto has received numerous professional and academic awards and speaks frequently before financial, legal and other professional organizations in the U.S. and Europe . He is President of AIDA US and is a Director of the Insurance Federation of New York . He has served on the Boards of several companies.

Mr. Acunto holds both his B.A. and M.A. degrees (1971, 1973) in classical philology from New York University . He studied both in the US and abroad and is fluent in Italian, French and German. He is a Lecturer for the European School of Economics.

Mr. Acunto serves as a Trustee of the John Cabot University of Rome and has served as a Trustee of the College of Mt. St. Vincent and of the State University of New York (SUNY), Westchester College from 1983 to 1993. He is Chairman of The Montfort Academy, a private prep school. He is the author of *Westchester County , a History and Appreciation* published by Windsor Books (Whittier, CA 1991).

Mr. Acunto serves as Hon. Vice Consul for the Republic of Italy in New York State , with consular office in Westchester County , appointed in April, 2003. He is a member of the Consular Corps College . Among his recent achievements as VC, he delivered the Keynote Address to the New York State Historical Society in July 2009 entitled “Roma non sponte sequor” to introduce the Fenimore Cooper Museum ’s landmark exhibit, *America ’s Rome* . He is Chairman of the Italian Academy Foundation and publisher of its academic quarterly THE ITALIAN JOURNAL founded in 1949.

Mr. Acunto holds the rank and title of Commendatore of the Order of Merit of the Republic of Italy ; he is decorated with the rank of Cavaliere Ufficiale of the Order of Saints Maurice and Lazarus, the dynastic order of the House of Savoy. He is a Trustee of the Italian Legions of Merit.
